Teaching Style

We teach foreign language just as any child would learn their own mother tongue: through Total Physical Response and Acquisition.

Children learn most naturally by physically having to respond to their teacher. By connecting the physical action to the concept, a child learns the new word. Children also learn language one utterance, approximation, word and sentence at a time. They acquire language bit by bit.

We use a variety of developmentally age-appropriate activities to introduce new themes and words. Games, music, crafts, stories and dance are featured in all of our classes to create an interactive and fun learning process!

Our Mission

Our mission is to offer engaging immersion classes for children and to foster a community of families interested in bringing foreign language and culture into their homes.

We strongly believe in the value of early language education. Research shows that:

◆Learning a foreign language improves verbal and listening skills as well as analytical and math skills; more advanced reading skills and higher test scores in math and English literacy.

•The ability to communicate with people from another culture helps to build confidence as it is enjoyable and it also helps to build cultural connections that makes the world a better place.

Methodology

Our lively immersion classes integrate play, music, movement, and art to engage children and connect the foreign sounds and words to everyday items and activities.

We use a technique called 'Brain Dance' as a routine warm up each week in class. The brain dance is a series of fundamental movement patterns that wire the central nervous system laying the foundation for sensory-motor development and life long learning.

Our quarterly themes are brought to life through music, stories, and games that are often familiar to parents and easy to repeat in the home.

We provide weekly vocabulary and lyrics so parents can reinforce the language outside of class, whether or not the parent has previous language experience or fluency.

Children learn quickly! To support them, we encourage parents to learn along with their children.
