FUNDRAISING

Each year the PTA raises money to support community-building events, classroom needs, and enrichment opportunities like an in-class science specialist and clay program. We also have a grant program for our teachers to purchase learning and classroom supplies that our students use every day. We approach fundraising through a few key pathways:

- Fall Read-a-thon: In October, the whole school will engage in a collective focus on fun with literacy while raising money through pledges.
- **Spring Auction** and Annual Appeal: Get ready for a night of fun and fundraising in March with fellow HT parents and community members. This is our biggest fundraising event of the year.
- **Passive fundraisers**: Throughout the year families can help raise money through some activities, goods, and services that you may already be involved with or might want to be.

HT PTA is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization so you can double your contribution with your employee match program!

PASSIVE FUNDRAISERS

- Orcawear Sales: Show your school spirit and support 10% of all sales go to the school.
- <u>Fred Meyer Community Rewards:</u> Link your rewards card to Highland Terrace and the school gets a donation. This won't impact your savings or rewards in any way.
- Office Depot: When you make a purchase of qualifying school supplies, provide school ID at checkout and HT can receive 5% back in credits for supplies.
- <u>Full Circle Produce Box</u>: We will receive 10% back from new and existing customers every time an order is placed.
- <u>Smith Brother Farm Milk Fund</u>: Sign up for Smith Brothers Delivery and receive \$15 off your first order and they will donate \$50 to HT PTA. No contracts or minimum orders and you can cancel anytime.
- <u>Lynch Creek Farms</u>: During the holiday months we will be sending a link to order wreaths and other decor items. These are made locally and make great gifts! HT PTA receives 15% of all orders.
- <u>HT Mariner Game</u>: At the end of the year we sell tickets for HT families to attend a Mariner's game together, with a % going back to the school. More details in the spring!
- <u>Dine-Out Nights</u>: Throughout the year local restaurants like Habit Burger, Round Table and Spiro's Pizza will donate a percentage of sales to HT!
 - Our first one is at Round Table Pizza from Oct 8th-12th. Just mention the Highland Terrace fundraiser at check-out.
